## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPLETE THE WYOMING VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION BY MAIL DURING THE 14 DAYS BEFORE AN ELECTION

IMPORTANT: To register by mail (absentee registration) during the 14 days before an election, you MUST ALSO request and vote an absentee ballot.

- 1. <u>Voter Registration Application</u> can be completed online and then printed, or blank form printed and completed by you.
- 2. Complete Items 1-7 following all instructions on the Application. You must complete all REQUIRED information. Do not sign until you are in front of a Notary Public.
- 3. Item Number 3: You must provide the number of your valid Wyoming driver's license if one has been issued to you. Only if one has not been issued to you can you leave this off you application. If you do not have a Wyoming driver's license, you must provide the last four digits of your social security number.
- 4. Take the form to a Notary Public, or if you are in Wyoming, to the local County Clerk's Office. Show identification (ID) to satisfy their requirements to establish you are who you present yourself to be.
- 5. Read the "Voter Registration Oath" and, in the presence of the Notary Public/Registry Agent, sign beside the arrow.
- 6. Have the Notary Public/Registry Agent complete Section 12 indicating the type of identification shown. Section 13 needs to be completed and signed by the Notary Public/Registry Agent.
- 7. Mail the Registration Application along with a copy of your Wyoming Driver's License if one has been issued or other official photo ID if you have no Wyoming Driver's License to: Carrie Long, Sublette County Clerk, P O Box 250, Pinedale WY 82941.
- 8. Complete and return the Request for Sublette County, Wyoming Absentee Ballot according to instructions.

Upon receipt of the correctly completed application, you will be added to the Sublette County voter registration list and your absentee ballot will be mailed according to your request.

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

You are REQUIRED to send a copy of acceptable identification with your Registration Application and Ballot Request before an absentee ballot can be sent. If you have been issued a Wyoming Driver's License, send a copy of it. If you do not have a valid Wyoming Driver's License, see the "Acceptable Identification" section of the Wyoming Voter Registration Application Form Instructions (back page of application).

According to the federal Help America Vote Act of 2002, if you register to vote by MAIL, the first time you go to the polls to vote you will be REQUIRED to provide an acceptable identification document to the election official in order to vote, even though you showed ID in front of a Notary Public/Registry Agent when you completed to voter registration form.
