## **Fire Warden Annual Report**

January 1, 2020– December 31, 2020

### **I. EMERGENCY INCIDENTS**

• Between January 1, 2020– December 31, 2020, there were a total of 201 emergency responses:

- Pinedale – 77
- Big Piney/Marbleton – 39
- Bondurant – 19
- Boulder – 39
- Daniel – 23
- Kendall Valley – 4
- Our average turn-out time in 2020 was 10 minutes and 52 seconds.

### **II. FIRE INVESTIGATIONS**

- There were (11) eleven fire investigations between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020.

### **III. FIRE PREVENTION**

- **SMOKE DETECTOR PROGRAM**
  - 77 smoke detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2020.
- **FIRE WISE ASSESSMENTS** – 0 POSITION IS VACANT.
- **FIRE WISE TRAINING** –0 POSITION IS VACANT.
- **COLLABORATIVE MEETINGS** – 2
- **COMMUNITY EDUCATION EVENTS** – Two (2).

### **IV. TRAINING**

- **FIRE TRAINING**
  - In 2020 due to COVID-19 we started an online training program with a quiz at the end of each training class. This verifies the firefighters watched the YouTube training class and successfully passed the quiz to obtain the training point. This was successful and allowed our firefighters to stay compliant with the Wyoming Retirement System Rules and State Statutes 35-9-616 through 35-9-628.
  - 33 - State Issued Structure Training Qualifications were issued in 2020.
  - HNA-5; HMO-8; FF1-8; FF2-3; FSI-1-4; FO1-3; FO2-1; ADO-P-1
  - 12 – NWCG Wildland Qualifications were issued in 2020.
  - FFT2 -7; FFT1-2; FAL3-1; ENGB-1; DIVS-1
  - 288 classes were offered, with a total of 1,739:40 class hours. 2,026 firefighters attended with a total of 7,747:10 man hours.

## **V. HEALTH & SAFETY**

- Ben Swindlehurst was appointed Health & Safety Officer in 2020.
- The SOP has been updated along with a new Respiratory Protection Plan for firefighters.
- Critical Incident Stress Management team - CISM - is available in Sublette County.
- There three CISM debriefs held in 2020.

## **VI. HOURS SPENT IN 2020**

- The firefighters donated 2,158.25 volunteer hours throughout the County and community.
- Firefighters spent 2,875:40 hours with incident responses.
- Firefighters suppressed a total of 79 acres of wildland fires within Sublette County. 20 acres of government land and 59 acres on private land.

## **VII. Federal Fires**

- 22 Deployments to Federal Fires outside of Sublette County.
- \$206,126.81 was paid to firefighters from Federal Fire pass through funds. This has been reimbursed to Sublette County.
- Approximately \$171,804.80 was paid to Sublette County and put into reserve for future Wildland apparatus purchase.




