

Fire Warden Annual Report

January 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021

I. EMERGENCY INCIDENTS

- Between January 1, 2021– December 31, 2021, there were a total of 226 emergency responses:
 - Pinedale 98
 - Big Piney/Marbleton 40
 - Bondurant 17
 - Boulder 27
 - Daniel 28
 - Kendall Valley 16
 - Our average turn-out time in 2021 was 11 minutes and 51 seconds.

II. FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

• There were eleven (11) fire investigations between January 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021.

III. FIRE PREVENTION

- SMOKE DETECTOR PROGRAM
 - 32 smoke detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2021.
 - 9 carbon monoxide detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2021.
- FIRE WISE ASSESSMENTS 0 POSITION IS VACANT.
- FIRE WISE TRAINING –0 POSITION IS VACANT.
- COLLABORATIVE MEETINGS EIGHT (8).

IV. TRAINING

- FIRE TRAINING
 - 43 State Issued Structure Training Qualifications were issued in 2021.
 - HMA-12; HMO-11; FF1-11; FF2-1; FSI-1-2; FO1-1; FO2-2; FINV-2; ADO-

P-1.

- 36 NWCG Wildland Qualifications were issued in 2021.
- FFT2 -11; FFT1-10; FAL3-5; ENGB-4; ICT5-6.
- 245 classes were offered, with a total of 1,827:00 class hours. 1,875 firefighters attended with a total of 7,830:15-man hours.

V. HEALTH & SAFETY

- Health and Safety position is vacant.
- The SOP has been updated along with a new Respiratory Protection Plan for firefighters.
 - Exposure Control Plan.
 - Risk Management Plan.
- Critical Incident Stress Management team CISM is available in Sublette County. It was activated Four (4) times in 2021.

VI. HOURS SPENT IN 2020

- The firefighters donated 1,233.0 volunteer hours in 2021 throughout the County and Towns. These are hours in addition to incident response and training.
 - Firefighters spent 2,934:24 hours with incident responses.
- Firefighters suppressed a total of 142.92 acres of wildland fires within Sublette County. 107.95 acres of public land and 34.97 acres of private land.

VII. Federal Fires

- 9 Deployments to Federal Fires outside of Sublette County.
- \$145,041.88 was paid to firefighters from Federal Fire pass through funds. This amount has been reimbursed to Sublette County.
- The amount of \$131,944.38 was paid to Sublette County and put into Wildland Fire Reserve for future Wildland Apparatus purchase.

VIII. Grant Funds

In 2021 SCUF applied for and received the following grants.

SLIB Grant - \$1,000,000.00. (New Daniel Fire Hall and Road & Bridge Facility)

SFA Grant – \$5,000.00 (Wildland gloves and supplies.)


VFA Grant – \$5,000.00 (Wildland packs, boots.)




