

RESOLUTION NO. 01-711C

WHEREAS, in accordance with Wyo. Stat. § 11-31-301, the Board of County Commissioners may declare the running at large of specified animals in unincorporated areas within the County limits to be a public nuisance; and

WHEREAS, it would serve the public interest and welfare for such a resolution to be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

(1) That the running at large of any dog in unincorporated areas within the limits of Sublette County is hereby declared a public nuisance;

(2) That a notice of this declaration shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the County, and shall state that :

(i) It is a public nuisance for one (1) or more dogs to be running at large in unincorporated areas of Sublette County;

(ii) A fine shall be imposed on the owner of such animal and restitution for any damages to person or property caused by the animal shall be made by its owner; and

(iii) Dogs whose ownership cannot be determined, may be destroyed.
