SUBLETTE COUNTY, WYOMING

GENERAL ELECTION DAY: Tuesday, November 8, 2022

LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE: Monday, October 24, 2022

Voter registration will be permitted at the polls on general election day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022. A form of government issued photo identification will be required. Effective July 1, 2021, Wyoming voters will be required to show an acceptable form of identification when voting in person.

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT A

The Wyoming Constitution allows the state to invest state funds in equities such as the stock of corporations, but does not allow the funds of counties, cities and other political subdivisions to be invested in equities. The adoption of this amendment would allow the funds of counties, cities and other political subdivisions to be invested in equities to the extent and in the manner the legislature may allow by law. Any law authorizing the investment of specified political subdivision funds in equities would require a two-thirds vote of both houses of the legislature.

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT B

Currently, the Wyoming Constitution requires Wyoming Supreme Court justices and district court judges to retire upon reaching the age of seventy (70). This amendment increases the mandatory retirement age of Supreme Court justices and district court judges from age seventy (70) to age seventy-five (75).

CAMPAIGN FILING REQUIREMENTS

EVERY Candidate, Candidate's Campaign Committee and Political Action Committee shall file a Statement of Contributions and Expenditures between October 25, 2022 and November 1, 2022. Amendments must be filed by November 18, 2022. A candidate must file the statement as required by law before receiving a Certificate of Election.

If you require assistance to vote by reason of blindness, disability, or inability to write, you may be given assistance by a person of your choice. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact your County Clerk.

Any person who expects to be absent from his place of residence on Election Day may apply for an absentee ballot at the Office of the County Clerk, 21 S. Tyler; or by mail at P.O. Box 250, Pinedale, WY 82941; by telephone 367-4372; or email at carrie.long@sublettewyo.com. Absentee ballots may be requested through November 7, 2022. Early voting will be available at the County Clerk's Office September 23, 2022 to Monday, November 7, 2022. Voting hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
