OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS NOVEMBER 9, 2018

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Sublette County Courthouse in Pinedale, Wyoming, on this date at 9:00 a.m. with Andy Nelson, Joel Bousman, David Burnett, Tom Noble, Heidi Dabb of the <u>Pinedale Roundup</u>, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

Commissioner Mack Rawhouser was excused to attend Veterans Day ceremonies in Upton.

Chairman Nelson led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the preceding regular meeting of October 19, 2019, was approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Burnett and seconded by Commissioner Bousman. The motion carried.

The official bond for Margaret Kozeal, Treasurer for the Big Piney Cemetery District,, in the amount of \$2,000; Marilyn Jensen, Treasurer for the Boulder Mosquito Improvement District, in the amount of \$1,000; Shannon McCormick, Deputy Clerk, Town of Marbleton, in the amount of \$50,000; Mark Eatinger, Treasurer for the Museum Board, in the amount of \$1,500; Amy Commerer, Clerk to the Big Piney Cemetery District, in the amount of \$2,000; and Vern McAdams, Business Manager for School District #1, in the amount of \$250,000 were approved and ordered filed with the County Treasurer.

Billy Pape, Road and Bridge Superintendent, reported on plowing, dirt work, blading, culverts on North Piney, Jack Creek and Dell Creek roads, and Cottonwood roto mill. Pape reported that 65,000 cubic yards of gravel had been crushed at the Bain Pit and that the crusher will be returning to the Shop for maintenance and the crew will participate in MSHA training. Regarding the Roosevelt Fire, the Kismet Tower site can be excavated in one day, and wattles were delivered for Emergency Management to Hoback Ranches.

Mark Eatinger, representing Rio Verde Engineering, presented the current Skyline Rock report.

Skylar Wilson, County Surveyor, reported on the Bondurant Fire Hall property.

Billy Pape, Waste Management Superintendent, reported that 38 houses had been accepted at the Marbleton Landfill from Hoback Ranches in approximately 200 loads, and weighing 2500 tons. The C&D pit is filling with concrete and debris and will need to be surveyed. Pape reported on water testing, detours to save cattle guards, drainage issues at the Pinedale Transfer Station and future expansion planning, and DEQ permitting.

Sheriff KC Lehr reported on Search and Rescue and Halloween activities. Lt. Stephen Dunning reported on the Jail census of 30 per day, State housing, overtime, and employee burnout. Additional staffing was discussed and the Board requested additional information to continue the discussion.

Rob Hoelscher, District Ranger, reported on Sara Walker, Friends of the BT Coordinator, water projects at New Fork and Silver Lake, Skyline Drive rocks, and California fires. The Board discussed the Bondurant Fire Hall property, Lummis Park property, Joint Chiefs funding, and the lock on the Sandy Beach group site.

The following abatement petitions and affidavits of abatement of taxes were presented on petition from the County Assessor and the State of Wyoming Board of Equalization: Pinedale Energy Partners, \$4.20; Patterson UTI Drilling Company, LLL, \$36,087.58; Pinedale Energy Partners, \$38,104.26; Pinedale Energy Partners, \$2,598.47; and Pinedale Energy Partners, \$3,461.95.

The Board reviewed the WCCA County Road Fund report.

The Board approved and signed the Sublette County Local Emergency Planning Committee grant agreement.

It was moved by Commissioner Burnett and seconded by Commissioner Noble to approve and sign the Encroachment Agreement with the Town of Pinedale and the Food Basket. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Commissioner Burnett to award the bid of \$10,000 to Sam Bethea for Unified Fire's 1986 F350 4x4 Brush Truck. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Burnett and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to approve and sign a Memorandum of Understanding with the Sublette County Conservation District for the remodeling project. The motion carried.

Old Business. Commission Noble reported on the broadband meeting in Green River with its Broadband Joint Powers Board, and reported to the Board that he notified one of the RFP candidates that the process will not be extended. Commissioner Burnett reported on a teleconference on migration corridors, the weekly Roosevelt Fire conference call with reports from the Game and Fish, WYDOT, State Forrester, and Jim Mitchell. Commissioner Bousman reported on migration corridors, a BLM webinar, and the WCCA Winter meeting. Chairman Nelson reported on touring Enviremedial.

The Board discussed the Roosevelt Fire remediation. Jim Mitchell, Emergency Management Coordinator, reviewed various funding sources including Mineral Royalty, DEQ, HMPG, PDM, and FMA. The grant writing was discussed. It was reported that Homeland Security will be conducting a public meeting on Tuesday, November 13th at BOCES, concerning HMGP, PDM, and FMA funding for post fire assistance. Commissioner Burnett will be the contact for the Fire issues.

Dave Nemitz, representing Hoback Ranches Service and Improvement District, requested that the County's Consensus funding be distributed to the District. The Board directed the Clerk to set a future Consensus funding meeting for all of the eligible applicants to present projects to develop the Consensus List for the County. Nemitz requested support for the District's Emergency MRG application to the Wyoming Business Council. The Board scheduled the application review for the November 20th meeting.

Commissioner Burnett discussed the wattles that had been placed in Hoback Ranches.
