Fire Warden Annual Report

January 1, 2017- December 31, 2017

I. EMERGENCY INCIDENTS

- Between January 1, 2017 December 31, 2017, there were a total of 191 emergency responses:
 - Pinedale 71
 - Big Piney/Marbleton 44
 - Bondurant 15
 - Boulder 32
 - Daniel 19
 - Kendall Valley 10
- Our average turn out time in 2017 was 9 minutes and 22 seconds.

II. FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

• There were (10) ten fire investigations between January 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017.

III. FIRE PREVENTION

- SMOKE DETECTOR PROGRAM
 - 129 smoke detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2017.
 - SLASH PILES BURNED Twenty Eight (28)
 - COMMUNITY EDUCATION EVENTS Thirteen (13)

IV. TRAINING

- FIRE TRAINING
 - 72 State Issued Training Qualifications and 10 Pro Boards were issued in 2017. This is more than any other agency in the state of Wyoming.
 - 271 classes were offered, with a total of 2081:30 class hours. 2189 firefighters attended with a total of 8326:45-man hours.

V. HEALTH & SAFETY


- A MOU was signed with Brian Barton, PA to oversee the health and fitness program.
- Firefighters are up to date with CPR and First Aid.
- Completed 77 physicals and 74 stress tests in 2017. Eight firefighters were identified as needing follow up prior to arduous classification.
- The Accountability Program is up and running.

VI. HOURS SPENT IN 2017

- The firefighters donated 2,210.75 volunteer hours throughout the County and community.
- Firefighters spent 2,157:11 hours with Alarm responses.
- Training hours for firefighters totaled 8276:15 hours.


