Fire Warden Annual Report

January 1, 2019- December 31, 2019

I. EMERGENCY INCIDENTS

- Between January 1, 2019 December 31, 2019, there were a total of 206 emergency responses:
 - Pinedale 88
 - Big Piney/Marbleton 37
 - Bondurant 25
 - Boulder 31
 - Daniel 14
 - Kendall Valley 11
 - Our average turn-out time in 2019 was 10 minutes and 35 seconds.

II. FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

• There were (10) ten fire investigations between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019.

III. FIRE PREVENTION

- SMOKE DETECTOR PROGRAM
- 189 smoke detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2019 with the help of the Red Cross.
 - FIRE WISE ASSESSMENTS 3
 - FIRE WISE TRAINING Three days (tablet).
 - COLLABORATIVE MEETINGS 2
 - **COMMUNITY EDUCATION EVENTS** Sixteen (16).

IV. TRAINING

- FIRE TRAINING
 - 68 State Issued Structure Training Qualifications were issued in 2019.
 - 26 Wildland Certifications were issued in 2019.
- 290 classes were offered, with a total of 1,951:00 class hours. 2,662 firefighters attended with a total of 10,324:15 man hours.

V. HEALTH & SAFETY

- Firefighters are up to date with CPR and First Aid.
- Completed 80 physicals and 77 stress tests in 2019.
- CISM team is available in Sublette County.

VI. HOURS SPENT IN 2019


- The firefighters donated 3,077.50 volunteer hours throughout the County and community.
 - Firefighters spent 3,813:39 hours with Alarm responses.

VII. Federal Fires

- 7 Deployments to Federal Fires outside of Sublette County.
- 24 SCUF Firefighters were deployed on the Boulder Lake Fire.
- \$100,872.46 was paid to firefighters from Federal Fires. This has been reimbursed to Sublette County.
- Approximately \$45,626.75 for Fire Income to County for future Wildland apparatus purchase.




