## TRANSFER IN FROM ANOTHER STATE TO SUBLETTE COUNTY, WYOMING

Welcome to Sublette County. In order to license and title your vehicle in Wyoming, you will need to go through a few steps.

1.	Title. Your original title from the issuing state.
2.	Vehicle Identification Number Inspection. You can have the VIN inspection done at the
	justice building located at 40 S. Fremont St, or you can call the Sheriff's department to come to a
	specified location to do the inspections (best option if you're changing multiple vehicles/trailers

3.	Current mileage (if the vehicle is 2011 or newer).
4.	Weight. Empty weight on pickup trucks, campers, and all trailers. A Weight Slip from
	the landfill may be required for trailers without a weight recorded on either the title or
	registration from the previous state.
5.	Registration and proof of insurance. Bring in your former state current or expired proof
	of registration or proof of sales tax paid. Also provide proof of current insurance.

	I be \$25. Once these steps are completed the Treasurer's office can issue you new Wyoming
	gistration. Wyoming Reg is based on MSRP, years of operation, and unladen weight.
<u>If the v</u>	vehicle is financed, we will need your lien holder information so that we can assist you
<u>in requ</u>	uesting your original title.
A Vehic	cle Identification Number Inspection is required for all vehicles transferring from out of state.
	the above <b>Steps 2-5</b> and bring to the Clerk's office. You will also need:
1.	Lien holder information. You will need to contact your lien holder and request an
	address or fax number for state-to-state transfers. A letter will be sent to the lien holder
	requesting your title be sent to the Clerk's office.
2.	Loan Document. The security agreement or financing statement from the lien holder.
3.	\$45. The title fee includes \$15.00 for the title, \$10.00 for the V.I.N. inspection, and \$20
	to file the lien.
When	your title is delivered to the Clerk's office, a Wyoming title will be made with the lien and sent
back to	the lien holder. A copy of the Wyoming title will be mailed to you. When it is time to renew
your re	egistration, you will bring the copy to the Treasurer's office so they can update their records.
4.	Registration and proof of insurance. Bring in your former state's current registration to
	easurer's office, together with proof of current insurance.

	*Note-Treasurer may only issue registration from a current registration AFTER we have

\*Note-Treasurer may only issue registration from a current registration <u>AFTER</u> we have received your finance agreement and VIN inspection forms.

<u>If registration is expired</u>, you will need to wait until the title is changed to a Wyoming title to register the vehicle.
