Fire Warden Annual Report

January 1, 2022 – December 31, 2022

I. EMERGENCY INCIDENTS

• Between January 1, 2022– December 31, 2022, there were a total of 215 emergency responses:

- Pinedale – 86
- Big Piney/Marbleton – 33
- Bondurant – 27
- Boulder – 37
- Daniel – 24
- Kendall Valley – 8
- Our average turn-out time in 2022 was 13 minutes and 00 seconds.

II. FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

• There were six (6) fire investigations between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022.

III. FIRE PREVENTION

- Smoke Detector Program
 - 13 smoke detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2022.
 - 9 carbon monoxide detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2022.
- Collaborative meetings – Four (4).
- A Community Wildfire Protection Plan was created for Sublette County in 2022.

IV. TRAINING

• FIRE TRAINING

- 36 - State Issued Structure Training Qualifications were issued in 2022.
- Haz-Mat Awareness-12; Haz-Mat Operations-7; Fire Fighter One-7; Fire Fighter Two-3; Fire Service Instructor One-3; Fire Service Instructor Two - 1; Fire Officer One -1; Fire Investigator -1; Apparatus Driver/Operator Pumper-1.
- 19 – NWCG Wildland Qualifications were issued in 2022.
- Fire Fighter Type Two -9; Fire Fighter Type One-4; Basic Faller -2; Engine Boss -1; Incident Commander Type Five-3.
- 172 classes were offered, with a total of 544:55 class hours. 1,525 firefighters attended with a total of 5,244:00-man hours.

V. HEALTH & SAFETY

- Critical Incident Stress Management team - CISM - is available in Sublette County. The team not activated in 2022.

VI. HOURS SPENT IN 2020

- The firefighters donated 1,536.0 volunteer hours in 2022 throughout the County and Towns. These are hours in addition to incident response and training.
- Firefighters spent 2,077:19 hours with incident responses.
- Firefighters suppressed a total of 99.25 acres of wildland fires within Sublette County. 96.5 acres of public land and 2.75 acres of private land.

VII. Federal Fires

- 11 Deployments to Federal Fires outside of Sublette County.
- \$169,262.23 was paid to firefighters from Federal Fire pass through funds. This amount has been reimbursed to Sublette County.
- The amount of \$109,201.61 was paid to Sublette County and put into Wildland Fire Reserve for future Wildland Apparatus purchase.

VIII. Grant Funds

In 2022 SCUF applied for and received the following grants.

SFA Grant – \$5,000.00 (Coaxsher Wildland Packs.)

VFA Grant – \$7,500.00 (Bunker Coats and Pants for Recruit Academy Graduates)

Anheuser Bush Grant – Free One Pallets of water for firefighters to drink while working on fires.

PENDING – CWDG Grant - \$1,019,950.00 to implement the CWPP in Sublette County.

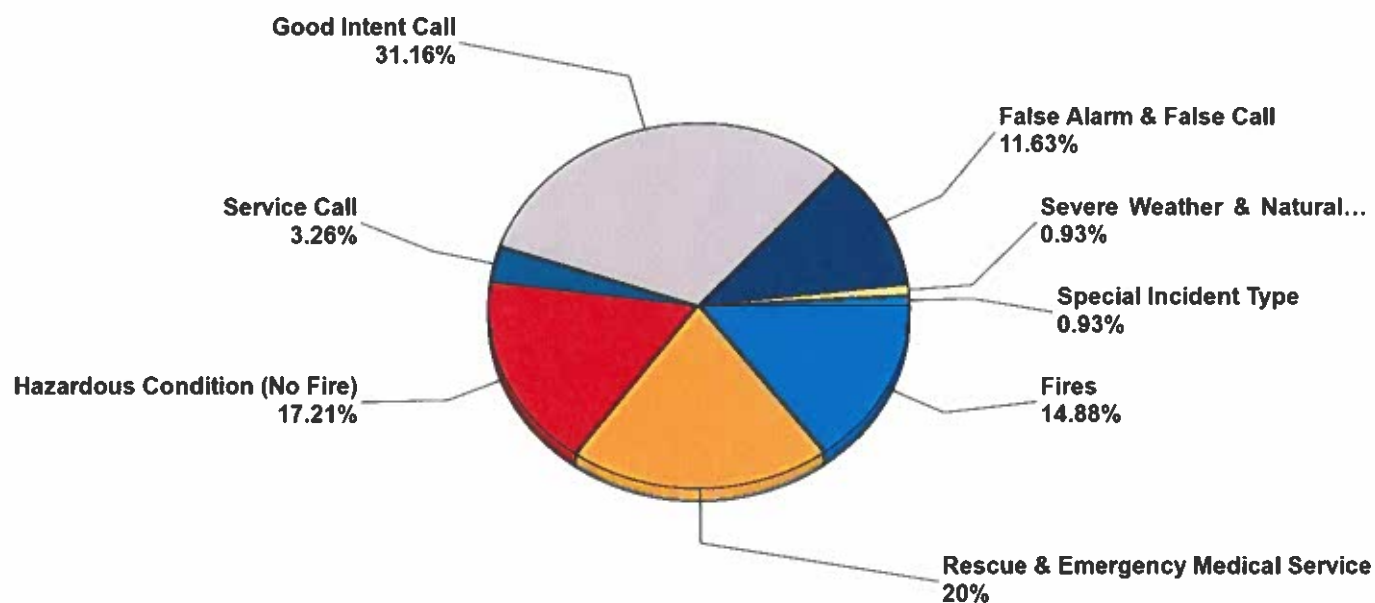

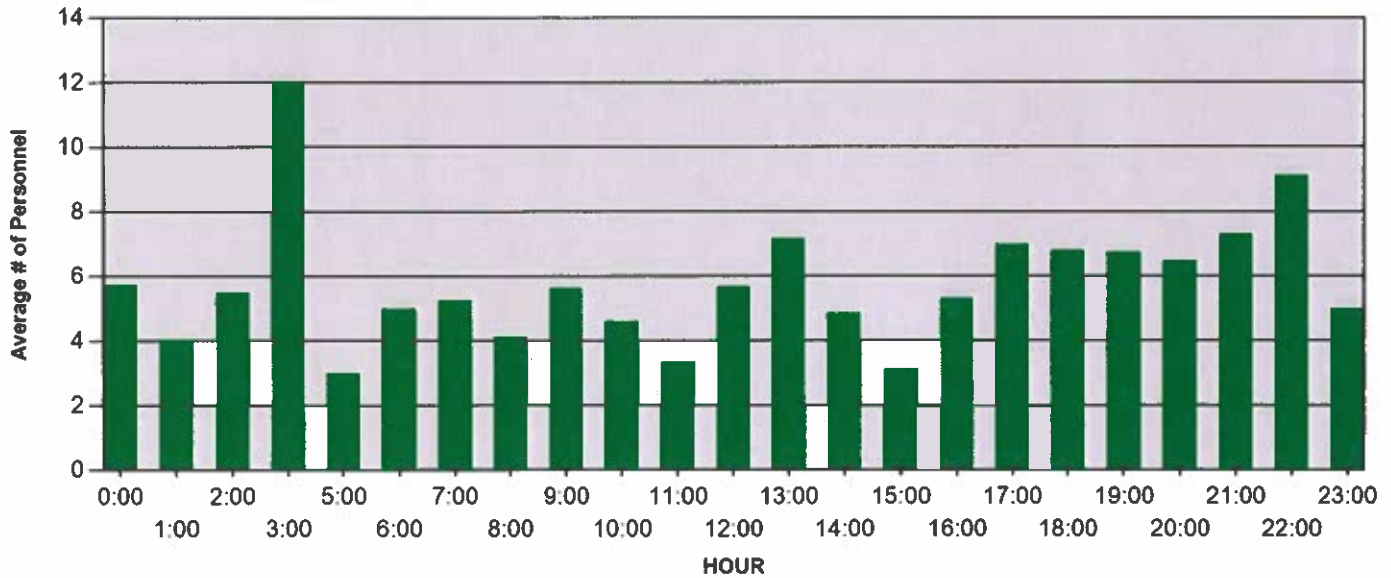

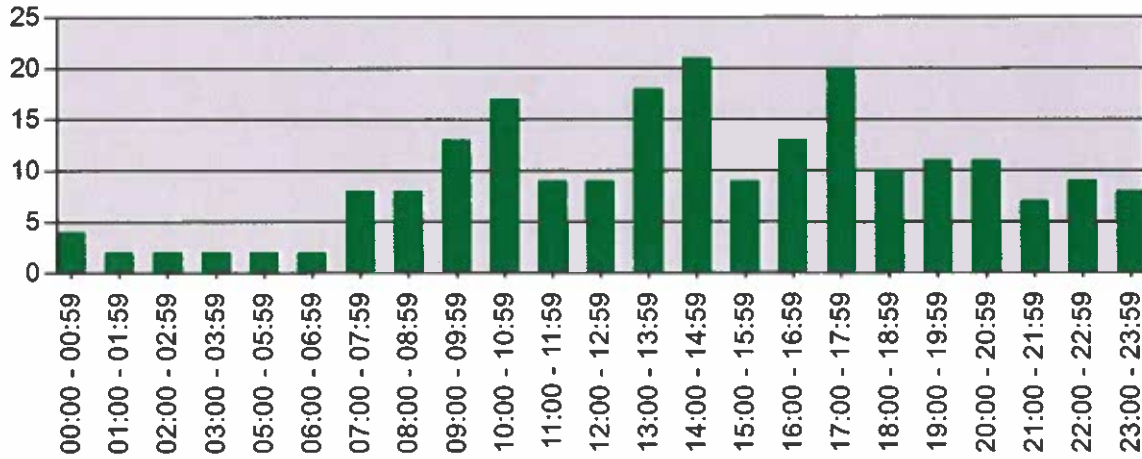

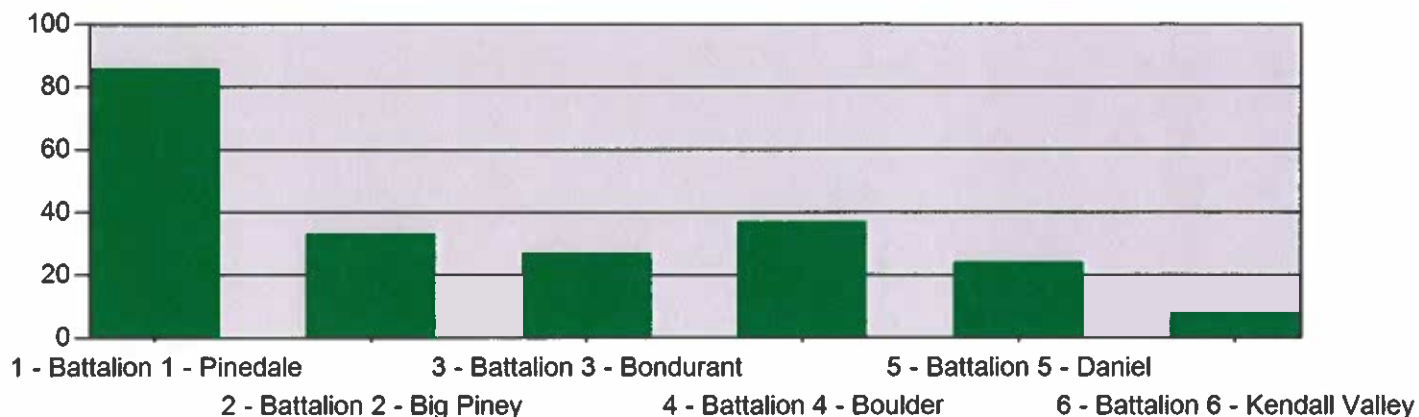

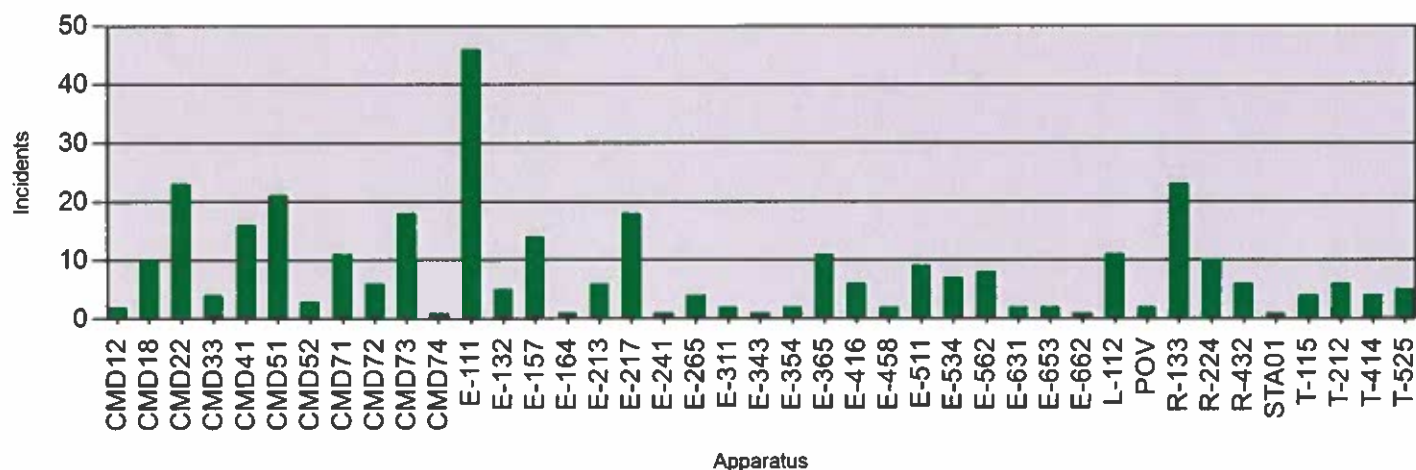
